1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.199 dated 16.05.2023 under Sections 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act') registered at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

2. Short affidavit of Sukhwinder Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City) Ferozepur, has been filed in the Court today which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions. A copy of the same has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

3. While drawing the attention of this Court to the affidavit filed, learned State counsel has submitted that the trial is nearing conclusion as four witnesses stand completely examined, four witnesses have been given up by the prosecution while four witnesses have been partly examined and they are due to be examined on the next date of



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hearing i.e. 19.09.2024, which would leave just one prosecution witness to be examined. Learned State counsel has, thus, prayed for dismissal of the instant petition.

- 4. In view of the stage of trial, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.
- 5. Dismissed as not pressed.
- 6. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
