The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.119 dated 08.08.2019 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station City Nawanshahr, District SBS Nagar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.02.2024, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.
