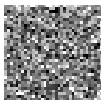

SANJIV BERRY, J.(ORAL)

By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 6 to take appropriate legal action on the basis of representation dated 12.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioner.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that apprehending danger to his life and liberty, the petitioner had moved the representation to the competent authorities for taking appropriate legal action but no action thereon has been taken. He had moved the representation (Annexure P-6) to respondent No.2, but till date no action thereon has been taken to redress the grievance of the petitioner. He submits that for the purpose of the petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2- The Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 12.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner by giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner as

- 3. Notice of motion to official respondents.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Adesh Pal Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that respondent No.2- The Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh, will consider and dispose of the representation in accordance with law.
- 5. After hearing the respective submissions and perusing the record, without commenting on the merits of the case and considering the limited request made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- The Director General of Police, Punjab Police Headquarter, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to consider and dispose of the representation dated 12.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner after giving opportunity of being heard to the petitioner.
- 6. The decision so taken be also intimated to the petitioner as well.
- 7. Disposed of.
