1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the private respondents. A further prayer has been made to consider and decide the representation dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P-7).

2. On an advance notice, Mr. I.P.S. Sabharwal, DAG, Punjab, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent-State and on instructions from ASI Sarabjeet Singh, he submits that one representation was received from the petitioners on 02.09.2024 and no cognizable offence was found to have been committed by anyone. Still further, it was also concluded that there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. He has also submitted that

two more representations have been received from the petitioners and one representation has been received from the private respondents and decision thereon shall be taken within a period of two days.

2. In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the State, no further orders are required to be passed and the present petition stands disposed of, accordingly.
