Present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* to quash the impugned order dated 29.09.2023 (P-17) passed by respondent No. 2, whereby second appeal of the petitioner under Section 19 (3) read with Section 20 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 was disposed off.

(2) Heard the petitioner and perused the record.

(3) Concededly, none of the respondent(s), including respondent No.2 who has passed the order impugned, is situated within the territorial jurisdiction of this Court; nor even a part of cause of action is made out to entertain the present writ petition.



(4) In view of the above legal impediment, there is no option, except to dispose off the writ petition with liberty to petitioner to avail his remedy before Hon’ble Delhi High Court, as per law, if so advised.
