By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has approached this Court *inter alia* for setting aside communication dated 05.11.2019, Annexure P-10, passed by respondent No.2, whereby petitioner's application seeking grant of fire arms licence has been rejected.
