1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 not to harass and humiliate the petitioner by unnecessarily calling him again and again in their office at the instance of private respondent No.5 and threatening him to implicate in some false cases if the petitioner does not compromise the matter with respondent No.5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a dispute pending between the petitioner and his landlord-respondent No.5 before the Court of learned Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Rajpura. It is in the aforementioned background respondent No.5, on account of influence that he wield over the official respondents, has been unnecessarily harassing the petitioner through the official respondents by calling him in the office of respondent No.3. It has been submitted that at the behest of respondent No.5, the official respondents have

been threatening to implicate the petitioner in false cases in case he does not compromise the matter with his landlord i.e. respondent No.5. Learned counsel submits that a representation in the said regard dated 11.10.2024 (Annexure P-10) has also been given to respondent No.2, however, in vain. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala to look into his representation dated 11.10.2024 (Annexure P-10) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala to look into the representation dated 11.10.2024 (Annexure P-10) and decide the same at the earliest, and take appropriate steps, if any required, in accordance with law.
