JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J.(ORAL)

1. The instant petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for seeking direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to release amount of compensation awarded by Commissioner under Employees Compensation Act, 1923.

2. The petitioner claims that Commissioner under Employees Compensation Act, 1923 has awarded compensation to them. A period of more than 1-1/2 years has passed away still they have not received awarded compensation. The authorities are sitting over the matter and not getting order executed.

3. Mr. Parminder Kanwar counsel for respondents No.1 to 3 submits that warrant of arrest dated 13.11.2024 has already been issued. Thus, claim of petitioner that authorities are not pursuing the matter is factually incorrect.

4. In the wake of statement of counsel for respondents, no interference is warranted. The petitioner is at liberty to pursue his grievance before the Authority.
