1. In pursuance of last order, compliance report by way of affidavit of Mr. Rajinder Singh Solanki, Additional Director (Administration) Directorate of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare Department Haryana, on behalf of respondent has been filed along with an order dated 14.11.2024, in Court today and the same is taken on record. As per the same, a sum of Rs.4,49,237/- has been sanctioned in favour of the petitioner towards the remaining reimbursement for medical treatment.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions, informs that the said amount shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of 10 days from today.

2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.
3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed being not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
5. It is also pointed out that in case any claim of the petitioner still survives, she would be at liberty to move an appropriate representation, before the quarter concerned, within a period of two weeks from today and the same be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon and it be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter.
