2. Vide order dated 06.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned State counsel filed status report dated 19.02.2024. The same is taken on record. He further, on instructions states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
