The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail in FIR No.5 dated 02.10.2024 registered under Sections 67(B) of Information Technology (Amendment) Act 2008 and Section 15 of the Prevention of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, at Police Station Cyber Crime Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 04.11.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
