1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') is for issuance of appropriate directions to the official respondents to trace out minor grand-daughter of the petitioner, who has been abducted by respondent No.6 in collusion with his wife, sister and other family members and hand over her custody to the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that the present petition filed by the petitioner is totally misconceived. The grand-daughter of the petitioner was produced before the jurisdictional Magistrate and her

statement under Section 183 of BNSS (*erstwhile Section 164 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973*) has been recorded on 07.11.2024, in which she categorically stated that the petitioner is having some enmity with respondent No.6 and under her pressure, she lodged a false case against him and now she does not want to take any action against respondent No.6. The grand-daughter of the petitioner further stated that the petitioner mistreats her and she wants to live with her real aunt.

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
