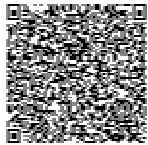

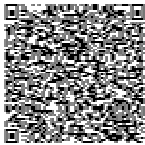

MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has made prayer for issuing a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release him on emergency parole for a period of two months on medical grounds.
2. Upon notice, reply by way of affidavit of the Superintendent, District Jail, Mansa has been filed today in Court, which is taken on record. It is submitted therein and learned State counsel has argued that the application of the petitioner for releasing him on emergency parole was rejected by the competent authority on the ground that he could abscond during parole and indulge in commission of similar offences as he was involved in several criminal cases under the NDPS Act. It is further submitted that in order to provide him medical attention, the petitioner was sent to AIIMS, Bathinda in the month of February, 2024 for surgery of his hip but he had refused for the same.

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3. Faced with the same, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may be disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to ensure the surgery of the hip of the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents-authorities to provide proper medical treatment to the petitioner and arrange for the surgery of his hip, as required, on emergency basis.
