KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, prayer is made for issuing a *mandamus* upon the official respondents to initiate proceedings against respondent no.5 under Sections 216 and 217 of the BNS, 2023, for filing multiple and repeated false and frivolous complaints against the petitioner.

2. A perusal of the instant petition reflects that, in fact the instant petition is a misconceived motion, inasmuch as, despite the petitioner being seized of an alternate and efficacious statutory remedy for redressal of his grievance, yet he has sidetracked the said remedy and have straightway accessed this Court, through instituting the present petition.

3. Faced with the above difficulty, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition,

however, with liberty reserved to the petitioner to recourse with an alternative available statutory remedy(ies) before the appropriate court/authority/forum concerned, for redressal of his grievance.

4. **Dismissed as withdrawn** with the aforesaid liberty.
