Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to arrest respondent No.4 who has been declared a proclaimed offender vide order dated 31.08.2024 (Annexure P-2) in criminal complaint bearing No.NACT/2399/2021 dated 07.07.2021 (Annexure P-1) titled as Prabhu Kumar vs. Chander Kumar Yadav, passed by learned JMIC, Amritsar, as despite of submission of representation dated 02.09.2024 to arrest respondent No.4, till date he has not been arrested.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was declared as proclaimed person vide order dated 31.08.2024 in afore-said complaint. He has submitted that the respondent-authorities are intentionally not arresting respondent No.4 and thus, the complaint filed by the petitioner is pending adjudication since the date of its filing.

4. Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

5. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the State to take necessary action in pursuant to the issuance of impugned order dated 31.08.2024, wherein, respondent No.4 has been declared proclaimed person, expeditiously.
