SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of directions to Respondents no. 2 to 5 to decide the application dated 24.06.2024 of the petitioner for seeking parole for 56 days expeditiously and within a reasonable time period and further to grant parole to the petitioner for a period of eight weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an application dated 24.06.2024 has been submitted before respondent No.3-SSP, SAS Nagar, Mohali vide Diary No. 1148 dated 26.06.2024. The said application was forwarded on 29.06.2024 to the office of respondent No.4-Deputy Superintendent of Police, P.S. Mataur, City-I, SAS Nagar, Mohali which is pending adjudication since then. He further submits that due to inordinate delay in adjudication of the



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application seeking concession of parole, the petitioner was compelled to come before this Court.

Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances, respondents No. 3 and 4 are directed to decide the said application by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, if so has been received in their offices, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
