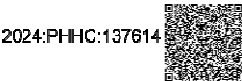

NAMIT KUMAR, J.

1. Petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondent No.6 to complete the inquiry marked to him by respondents No.3 and 4 regarding recruitment of Salesman-cum-Clerk and to appoint the petitioner as Salesman-cum-Clerk on finding that certificate of experience of respondent No.7 is illegal as the petitioner is at serial No.2 in the merit list.

2. The grievance of the petitioner in the present writ petition is that in pursuance to advertisement dated 21.08.2024 published by respondent No.5 for the post of Salesman-cum-Clerk, petitioner is at serial No.2 in the merit list and respondent No.7 being at serial No.1 has been appointed and whereas his experience certificate is not in order and the petitioner has submitted representation dated 23.09.2024 (Annexure P-5) against the appointment of respondent No.7. On the said representation vide order dated 27.09.2024 (Annexure P-6),

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inquiry has been marked to respondent No.6 i.e. Inspector, Co-operative Society, Bareta, Tehsil Budhlada, District Mansa, and respondent No.6 had called the petitioner on 11.10.2024, however, nothing further has been done by respondent No.6 in the said inquiry.

3. Present petition is dated 14.10.2024, although filed on 18.10.2024. It is the case of the petitioner himself that he had been called by respondent No.6 on 11.10.2024. Thus, present petition is pre-mature as the petitioner has filed the instant petition in hurry without awaiting the outcome of the inquiry.

4. Dismissed as pre-mature.
