[1] The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail by way of petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.27, dated 20.01.2016 under Sections 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 23, 29 PC and PNDT Act, registered at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal, Haryana.

[2] On 06.11.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“ Present: Mr. Mazlish Khan, Advocate for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the present FIR is of the year 2016 and earlier the petitioner did not have any apprehension of arrest and now after a period of seven years, the police has issued notice to the petitioner for appearance and now he has an apprehension of arrest. He further submitted that some of the other co-accused have already been admitted to bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Adjourned to 15.02.2024.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and to co-operate fully with the investigation process and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail, subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

[3] Today, learned State Counsel, has informed this Court that the petitioner has joined the investigation, in compliance of the order dated 06.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

[4] In view of the aforesaid, the order dated 06.11.2023, whereby the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute. However, he shall continue to join investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
