MAIN CASES

With the consent of counsel for the petitioner(s), both these writ petitions are being decided by a common order since the issues involved therein are identical. For the facility of reference, the facts are, however, taken from CWP-28621-2024.

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CWP-28621-2024 (O&M) + 1 case

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Challenge in the said petition is to the order dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.1- National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi in First Appeal No.237 of 2021 as well as to the order dated 17.11.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2- State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Punjab in complaint No.215 of 2020.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the petitioner(s) had filed three writ petitions involving similar issues against the orders passed by the National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, New Delhi and that one of the three petitions i.e. CWP-28439 of 2024 was listed before a Division Bench at Sr. No.124 today. He contends that the same has already been dismissed.

Since the issues involved in the present writ petitions are identical and the Division Bench has already dismissed one of the writ petitions, I am of the opinion that the present writ petitions also deserve the same treatment and accordingly, the same are dismissed in view of the order of even date passed by the Division Bench of this Court in CWP-28439-2024.
