1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of BNSS 2023 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.216 dated 14.05.2024, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 34 IPC, Police Station Civil Lines, Sirsa.
2. After arguing for some time, the counsel for the petitioner made prayer that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition but liberty be given to him to surrender before the learned trial Court within a period of next 7 days and till then, no coercive action be taken against the petitioner.
3. The prayer is not opposed by the State counsel.
4. In light of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn. The petitioner should surrender within next 7 days before the Court concerned. During the said period of 7 days, no coercive action is to be taken against the petitioner.
5. Pending application, if any, stands disposed of.
