RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against respondent No.2 for non-compliance of order dated 01.03.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-4114-2023.
2. Compliance affidavit of respondent No.3 has been filed by learned State counsel and reply on behalf of respondent No.5 has been filed by learned counsel for respondent No.5 today in the Court. The same are taken on record. Learned State counsel has submitted that as per the compliance affidavit of respondent No.3, the petition filed by the petitioner under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 has been dismissed, vide order dated 05.12.2023.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
