AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

Petitioner-Kali @ Sandeep has filed the present petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for grant of regular bail in FIR No.113, dated 22.09.2024, under Section 304 of BNS, 2023 (Section 317 (2) of BNS, 2023 added later on), registered at Police Station Meharban, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

2. As per facts of the case, Karan Kumar gave his statement that on 21.09.2024 at about 8.30 A.M., he was going for their work along with his cousin on motorcycle No. PB-91-N-0676. At about 8.40 a.m. when they reached near Shashi Kamal Factory, they were stopped by three persons. Said persons told him to give his valuable things to which he resisted. One of the person took out keys of his motorcycle and other person gave daat blow on his right hand and they forcibly took away his mobile phone from his pocket. His cousin-Lavkush also resisted and one of the person threw a brick bat blow towards him. On seeing, persons

gathering there, the assailants managed to fled away from the spot on their



motorcycle. With these allegations, present FIR has been registered.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner argued that petitioner was granted interim relief vide order dated 22.10.2024. He has joined the investigation and motorcycle No. PB-10-EJ-8095 make splendor has been recovered. He is ready to abide by the terms of bail order, therefore, his anticipatory bail application may be allowed.

4. Status report is filed. Facts narrated in the FIR are confirmed. It is also confirmed that petitioner has joined the investigation and motorcycle has been recovered. It is further made clear that petitioner is not required for further investigation.

5. In view of the aforesaid factual position, no purpose would be served by sending petitioner behind the bars. He has cooperated in the investigation. Presentation of challan and trial may take some time. Therefore, anticipatory bail petition filed by petitioner – Kali @ Sandeep is allowed. He be not arrested. In case of his arrest, he be released on bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer concerned, subject to condition that petitioner will join investigation as and when required. He will not tamper with or interfere with investigation and will not leave country without prior permission as provided under Section 482(2) of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
