1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate direction to official respondents to release the petitioner on 70 days parole, in case FIR No.128, dated 24.06.2006, under Sections 302, 25/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station KUK, District Kurukshetra.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 17.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) to the Jail Superintendent, Jagadhari Jail, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana and he shall be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.4 is directed to look into representation dated 17.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Jail Superintendent, Jagadhari Jail, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana-respondent No.4 to consider the representation dated 17.10.2024 (Annexure P-1) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
