1. The petitioner herein is a rice miller. In the State of Punjab, the various instrumentalities of the State purchased paddy in order to contribute rice for the central pool. For that purpose, de-husking paddy is given to the private rice millers. Every year, the State of Punjab comes out with Custom Milling Policy. Under that policy, the rice miller is required to get himself registered in order to get the allotment. The petitioner's application for registration is pending with the Director,. Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab.
2. The learned counsel representing the parties are *ad-idem* that the application filed by the petitioner with a request to register him for allotment shall be decided within a period of ten days, from today.
3. With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.



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4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
