VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 24.07.2024 (Annexure P-8) whereby the application under Order 7 Rule 11 for rejection of the plaint has been dismissed.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to take up all points, which are available to him, during the course of trial. It is further submitted that the petitioner be also permitted to move an application for deciding certain issues as preliminary issues.
3. In view of the above, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw the present revision petition with liberty to take all points which have been raised in the written statement and are available to him, during the course of trial.
4. Needless to say that it is always open to a party to move an application for framing certain issues as preliminary issues and no specific permission of this Court would be required for the same, however, in case, any such application is moved, this Court is sanguine that the trial Court would decide the same in accordance with law after hearing all the parties.
