SUVIR SEHGAL, J.(ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing impugned order dated 24.12.2018, Annexure P-8.
2. At the outset, Mr. Lohan, who is representing respondents No.2 to 4 submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.01.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner participated in the election process and was elected as a Chairman. He submits that the term of the Board of Directors has expired in the interregnum and the prayer made in the petition has become infructuous. He submits that the petitioner had misled this Court by appending forged documents. He seeks permission to avail the remedy available to him in accordance with law.
3. Writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is granted to respondents No.2 to 4 to take recourse to the remedy available to them in accordance with law.
