Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner may appear before respondent No. 1 on 08.01.2025 at 11.00 a.m. alongwith all documents and upon hearing her, speaking order shall be passed within a period of one week thereafter, which will be conveyed to her within one week thereafter.

costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
