The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.34 dated 28.03.2023 registered under Sections 21, 22, 29 of the NDPS Act and Sections 10, 11 and 12 of the Aircraft Act (added later on) at Police Station Gharinda, District Rural.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders dated 06.11.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim orders dated 06.11.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
