MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.123 dated 22.09.2023 under Sections 452, 323, 506, 148, 149 of the IPC registered at Police Station Vario Ke, District Fazilka.

2. On 06.11.2023, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner, while drawing the attention of this Court to the allegations levelled in the FIR in question which has been annexed as Annexure P-1, inter alia contends that the petitioner has been attributed a stick blow on the right hand of the injured which injury was opined to be simple in nature. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the investigating agency.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 06.11.2023, the petitioner has joined

investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ved Parkash, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.11.2023, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
