Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon an order dated 20.11.2024 to contend that Ex-gratia grant of Rs. 3 lakhs in favour of the petitioner stands released, whereas the payment of interest on the said amount is under consideration before the authorities concerned and the needful shall be done within a period of three weeks from today.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of petitioner towards litigation

expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.
