1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to issue appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 5 to conduct the investigation in case FIR No. 257 dated 21.08.2018, registered under Sections 302,328,34 of IPC, Police Station Farrukh Nagar, Gurugram (Annexue P-1) and to take strict action against the accused, in accordance with law.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case, the investigation has already been conducted by the police and an untrace report has been prepared by the police. She further submits that the said report shall be presented before the competent Court of law within a period of 04 weeks from today, if already not presented.
3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed by this Court and the petition is accordingly disposed off.

4. Needless to observe that, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedies, if any, in accordance with law.
