1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.96 dated 16.06.2021, registered under Section 420 of IPC, at Police Station City-II, District Mansa.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has paid the entire outstanding amount to respondent No.2-Bank and has also joined the investigation in the present case, in compliance of order dated 07.11.2023.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 13.11.2023 and is no longer required for further investigation.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.2/complainant also submits that the entire loan amount has been settled by the present petitioner and she has no objection, in case the present petition is allowed by this Court.

5. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 07.11.2023, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
