1. The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents, who are threatening the petitioner of killing him.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite representation dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P/7) having been given to the official respondents, the same has not been considered by the official respondents. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malekotla to look into the representation dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P/7) at the earliest and take appropriate steps as may be required under the law so that his life and liberty may not be jeopardized.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with directions to to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malekotla to look into the representation dated 09.10.2024 (Annexure P/7) and take necessary steps at the earliest, if any required, in accordance with law.
