The grievance of the petitioners is regarding non-registration of cognizable offence of cheating and forgery against the persons whose names were mentioned in the representations (Annexures P-4 and P-6) which were given to the Police authorities as early as on 18.07.2024 and 04.10.2024 respectively.
2. In view of the above, it is obvious that the petitioners can very well approach the concerned Magistrate under Section 175(3) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023 (earlier Section 156(3) of the Cr.P.C.) for amelioration of their grievance.
3. Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the matter, this Court extends liberty to the petitioners to avail the said remedy.
4. The petition, accordingly, stands disposed of.
