Learned counsel for the respondents submits that though the petitioner has been accorded the benefit of the promotion to the post of Superintendent Grade-II in the office of Deputy Commissioner, Bathinda, w.e.f. 20.06.2018 instead of 02.09.2020, however, the financial benefits shall be released to him within a period of three weeks from today.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition any further.

[3] **Dismissed as not pressed.**

[4] However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring / concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of petitioner towards litigation

expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

[5] Rule stands discharged.
