1. Prayer in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent No.3 (Commissioner, Hisar Division, District Hisar) to hear the revision petition along with stay application filed by the petitioners titled as **Roshal Lal etc. vs. Daharambir etc.** (Annexure P-1), in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel appeared in pursuance to advance copy of petition having been served upon the State. Learned State counsel on instructions from Usha Madhu, Reader, Divisional Commissioner, Hisar submits that revision petition filed by the petitioners is pending consideration before respondent No.3-Commissioner, Hisar Division, District Hisar and the same is fixed for 12.11.2024. Learned State counsel informs the Court that the stay application filed by the petitioners along with revision petition will



be decided on the date fixed i.e. 12.11.2024 and in any case not beyond 2 weeks thereafter.

3. In view of the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner, Hisar Division, District Hisar to consider and decide stay application positively, preferably within 2 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in any case not beyond 2 weeks thereafter.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
