1. The petitioner through instant petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 18.09.2024 (Annexure P-7) whereby his claim for reinstatement has been declined.
2. The petitioner in terms of Rules 12.24 and 12.25 of Punjab Police Rules, 1934 has applied for reinstatement. He had sought voluntary retirement and wants to withdraw his request which was accepted on 31.01.2022.
3. Mr. Dhir, at the outset, submits that appeal of petitioner is under active consideration. An appropriate order would be passed within 8 weeks from today.

4. Mr. Navjot Singh, Advocate submits that petition may be disposed of in the light of statement of Mr. Dhir.
5. In view of abovesaid statements, the petition stands disposed of.
6. Pending Miscellaneous Applications, if any, stand disposed of.
