MANISHA BATRA, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by providing police protection to him and also for restraining respondents No. 4 to 7 from harassing the petitioner and not to perform the marriage of their daughter as she is already married with the petitioner.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed a representation on 18.10.2024 (*Annexure P-2*) before respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) raising his grievances as raised in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.
3. Notice of motion.



4. Ms. Ruchika Sabherwal, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, has accepted the notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paperbook be supplied to her during the course of the day.

5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) to decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide him adequate security in order to protect his life and liberty and would also take further action, as per law.
