1. Present petition has been filed praying for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.04, dated 26.09.2024 under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Crime Branch, Sector-11, Chandigarh on account of his marriage, which is to be held on 28.10.2024.
2. Short reply on behalf of the respondent-State has been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record.
3. Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer made by the petitioner in the present case and he, on instructions, has submitted that the marriage is fixed for 28.10.2024, however, it has been apprised to the Court that the petitioner has been arrested on 26.09.2024 in this case and a heavy commercial quantity i.e. 400 bottles (100ml each) of Tusklis-Tough syrup, Triprolidine Hydrochloride Codeine Phosphate Syrup, has been recovered from him. It is submitted that investigation is going on and report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. is yet to be filed and there are every chances of his being absconding in case interim bail is granted to the petitioner.



4. In view of the above submissions, this Court finds that a heavy commercial quantity of Tusklis-T Cough Syrup, has been recovered from the petitioner, who was arrested on 26.09.2024 and the investigation is yet to be completed. Taking in view the abovesaid facts in consideration, no ground is made out for granting interim bail to the petitioner and the same is, therefore, declined.

5. Petition stands dismissed.
