Compliance report by way of affidavit dated 19.11.2024 filed on behalf of respondent No. 3, is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to the opposite side. In view thereof, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the necessary compliance has been made, while regularizing the services of petitioner as Pump Attendant w.e.f 01.02.1996 and the payment of arrears amounting to Rs. 12,08,928/- has been released / sent to Treasury on 18.11.2024. He thus, submits that no further cause survives in the present petition.

[2] In view of the above, learned counsel for petitioner does not press the present petition.

[3] Dismissed as not pressed.

[4] However, in case, any claim of the petitioner still survives, he would be at liberty to raise his claim by filing representation / counter calculations before the quarter concerned within a period of two weeks from today, which shall be dealt with, as per law, within a period of four weeks thereafter from the date of its receipt by passing a speaking order thereupon, which shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks thereafter and in case of any delay on the part of respondent(s), the officer(s) concerned would be liable to pay costs of Rs. 50,000/- to the petitioner from his / her own pocket.
