The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.98 dated 12.05.2023 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 506 and 34 IPC and Section 308 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 08.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 08.11.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.
