1. Present revision petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the order dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional District Judge, Mansa and order dated 11.05.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Mansa.

2. On 05.11.2024, this Court was pleased to pass the following order: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per his instructions, the petitioner has paid the maintenance at the rate of Rs.2500/- per month to the respondent and has further submitted that the petitioner wishes to finally settle the matter with the respondent and is also ready to bear the litigation expenses of the respondent.

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The petitioner is directed to prepare a demand draft of an amount of Rs.30,000/- in the name of the respondent and produce the same before this Court on the next date of hearing.

It is made clear that in case the said demand draft is not produced on the next date of hearing, then the petition would be liable to be dismissed.”

- 3. Neither a demand draft of Rs.30,000/- has been produced by the petitioner nor as per the report of the Registry the process fee has been deposited.
- 4. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
- 5. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present revision petition after complying with the above-said order dated 05.11.2024 and also after annexing a copy of the demand draft of an amount of Rs.30,000/- in the name of the respondent.
