anticipatory bail by this Court in CRM-M-51883-2023 and the
dispute is a financial dispute between the parties.*

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-51883-2023.

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the
investigation and to co-operate fully with the investigation process
and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject
to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of
Arresting /Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall
continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so*

and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C."

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the order dated 08.11.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Paramjit Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further custodial interrogation.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 08.11.2023, is hereby made absolute.
