The instant petition has been instituted under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the sale deed and transfer the share of property in name of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, he has submitted application dated 11.10.2023 to the respondent No.3-District Collector, Nawanshahr, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar but no action has been taken by the said Department.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that at this juncture, he would be satisfied if respondent No.3-District Collector, Nawanshahr, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar is directed to consider and decide the application dated 11.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) in a time bound manner.



Learned State Counsel does not oppose the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, in view of the above, with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.3-District Collector, Nawanshahr, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar to consider and decide the application dated 11.10.2023 (Annexure P-2) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
