1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondent No.5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.8 to 13.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the representation dated 19.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) addressed to Financial Commissioner, Revenue, Punjab, Deputy Commissioner, Gurdaspur, Secretary Home (Civil Secretariat, Punjab), Chief Director, Vigilance Bureau, Punjab and Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, but none of the authorities have taken any action so far on the said representation, wherein serious allegations of forging the signatures of Gurdev Singh and Sarnjit Kaur as well as tempering with the public document have been made alleging corruption on the part of Naib Tehsildar at Batala.
3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Jaspal Singh Guru, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State, who undertakes to decide the said representation dated 19.06.2024 (Annexure P-6) within a period of one week from today.
5. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioners within one week thereafter.
6. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the instant petition, therefore, prays for withdrawal of the same.
7. Prayer is accepted.
8. Dismissed as withdrawn.
