1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, at the hands of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka and he shall be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into representation dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure P-5) and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.
3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka-respondent No.2 to consider the
