Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned charge sheet dated 27.05.2022 (Annexure P-4) to the extent departmental proceedings have been initiated against the petitioner due to his involvement in FIR No. 15 dated 21.04.2022 registered under Sections 7 and 7(A) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station State Vigilance Bureau, Faridabad.
