1. Prayer in the present petition has been made for directing to the official respondents to submit challan before the learned Trial Court after conducting fair and impartial investigation in FIR No.221 dated 28.10.2023 registered under Sections 427, 447, 511, 120-B, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar.

2. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the FIR has been registered on 28.10.2023 but till date there is no progress in the investigation as the investigating agencies are not keen to proceed with the same.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Tarun Aggarwal, Sr. D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and he on instructions from ASI Prem Singh, has submitted that the investigation is already in progress. He submits that the allegations against the persons named in the FIR could not be substantiated and the other accused are



unknown and investigation is going on. He submits that the same would be concluded within a period of four weeks.

5. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the Investigating Agency to conclude the investigation in the present case within a period of four weeks from today.
