1. Challenge in the present petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India is to order dated 19.10.2024 (Annexure P-8) passed by Civil Judge (Junior Division), Jind, whereby the application filed by the plaintiff-petitioner for grant of police help to harvest the paddy crop has been dismissed.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the respondents violated the stay order passed by the trial Court and have harvested the paddy crop. The petitioner has also filed a complaint to the police authorities in that regard.
3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and he seeks withdrawal of the same with liberty to take appropriate remedy, as available in law, aggrieved by the aforesaid.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
