The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking quashing of the impugned complaint bearing No. COMA/89252/2023, dated 22.12.2023, titled as **“Guru Nanak College of Education Vs. Harjeet Kaur,”** (Annexure P-17) as well as summoning order dated 19.01.2024 vide which the petitioner-accused has been

summoned to face trial under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 alongwith order dated 26.07.2024 (Annexure P-18 colly) issuing bailable warrants against the petitioner-accused.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the case of the petitioner is squarely covered by the judgment of this Court rendered in the case “Neetu Rani vs. Guru Nanak College of Education and others”, CRM-M-16772-2024, decided on 23.07.2024 (Annexure P-21). The said fact has not been disputed by the opposite counsel.

In view of above, the present petition is allowed in terms of order dated 23.07.2024, passed in CRM-M-16772-2024 (Annexure P-21).

Pending criminal misc. Application, if any also stands disposed off.
